RESOLUTION PLEDGING THE FULL FAITH AND CREDIT OF THE COUNTY OF BAY, WITHIN CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS, FOR THE PAYMENT TEBO-ERICKSON DRAIN DRAINAGE DISTRICT 2020 DRAIN NOTE (Bay County, Michigan)

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the County of Bay, Michigan (the "County"), was held at County complex located at 515 Center Avenue, Bay City, Michigan 48708, on November 10, 2020. The following Commissioners were:

	esolution set forth below was offered by Commissioner	HEREK	and

WHEREAS pursuant to a petition filed with the Drain Commissioner of Bay County, State of Michigan (the "Drain Commissioner"), proceedings have been taken under the provisions of Act 40, Public Acts of Michigan, 1956, as amended (the "Act"), for the making of certain intra-county drain improvements referred to as the Tebo-Erickson Drain Project (the "Project"), which is being undertaken by the Tebo-Erickson Drain Drainage District (the "Drainage District") in a Special Assessment District (the "Special Assessment District") established by the Drainage District; and

WHEREAS, the Project is necessary for the protection of the public health, convenience or welfare, and in order to provide funds to pay the costs of the Project, the Drain Commissioner intends to issue the Drainage District's 2020 Drain Note (the "Note") in an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000 pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, the principal of and interest on the Note will be payable from assessments to be made upon public corporations and benefited properties in the Special Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, the Bay County Board of Commissioners (the "Board") may, by resolution adopted by a majority of the members of the Board, pledge the full faith and credit of the County for the prompt payment of the principal of and interest on the Note pursuant to Section 276 of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the pledge of the full faith and credit of the County to the Note will reduce the cost of financing the Project and will be a benefit to the people of the County.

WHEREAS, the 2020 Drain Note is not a private activity bond for purposes of Section 141 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code");

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The limited tax full faith and credit of the County of Bay is hereby pledged for the prompt payment of the principal of and interest on the 2020 Drain Note in a par amount not to exceed \$1,700,000. In case of any deficiency in the assessments to be made to pay the principal of and interest on the Note as and when due, the County shall pay the amount of such deficiency out of its general funds as a first budget obligation and, if necessary, shall levy ad valorem taxes for such purpose against all taxable property within its limits, subject to constitutional and statutory limitations provided, however, that if it is necessary to reimburse the County for money, it is obligated to advance, it shall be the duty of the Bay County Drain Cmmissioner to at once levy an additional assessment as hereinbefore provided as such an amount as will make up the deficiency pursuant to Section 434 of the Drain Code.
- 2. Should the County advance County funds pursuant to the pledge made in this Resolution, the amounts shall be repaid to the County from assessments or reassessments made upon benefited properties in the Special Assessment District as provided in the Act.
- 3. The Chairperson of the Board, the County Executive, the County Clerk, the County Treasurer and any other official of the County, or any one or more of them ("Authorized Officers"), are authorized and directed to take all actions necessary or desirable for the issuance of the Note and to execute any documents or certificates necessary to complete the issuance of the Note, including, but not limited to, any applications including the Michigan Department of Treasury, Application for State Treasurer's Approval to Issue Long-Term Securities, any waivers, certificates, receipts, orders, agreements, instruments, and any certificates relating to federal or state securities laws, rules, or regulations and to participate in the preparation of a preliminary official statement and a final official statement for the Note and to sign such documents and give any approvals necessary therefor.
- 4. All previous resolutions of the Board of Commissioners of the County, or parts thereof, that are inconsistent with this resolution, are hereby rescinded.
