| WHEREAS, | Women are not the only targets; men, children and the elderly also are counted among the victims and, sadly, emotional scars are often permanent; and |
| WHEREAS, | According to a study by Break the Silence, 2006, witnessing violence is the strongest risk factor in transmitting violent behavior from one generation to the next; and |
| WHEREAS, | According to the Bureau of Justice Statistics Crime Data Brief, Intimate Partner Violence, February 2003, women accounted for 85% of the victims of intimate partner violence, men for approximately 15%; and |
| WHEREAS, | A coalition of organizations has emerged to directly confront this crisis. Law enforcement officials, those involved with shelters and hotline services, health care providers, the clergy and other concerned citizens are helping in the effort to end domestic violence. We must recognize the compassion and dedication of these volunteers and professionals, applaud their efforts and increase public understanding of this important problem. Therefore, Be It |

| WHEREAS, | The Gerstacker Foundation from Midland awarded a \$25,000 private foundation grant for law enforcement training/planning in terms of ADA compliance for special needs individuals; and |
| WHEREAS, | The proposal, on behalf of Bay, Midland, and Saginaw Sheriff Offices, was originally submitted by Rich Lively, a then employee of the Saginaw County Sheriff's Office; and |
| WHEREAS, | Mr. Lively was laid off from Saginaw County in May 2011 and hired as a contractor for the Region 3 Homeland Security Planning Board; and |
| WHEREAS, | With input and concurrence from the Bay County Sheriff and the Undersheriff, a plan has been developed for this project; and |
| WHEREAS, | Saginaw County has suggested, due to Mr. Lively's layoff and the fact that this coincides with activities for the Region 3 HSPB, they prefer to have the funds directed to the Region 3 HSPB with Bay County acting as fiduciary; and |
| WHEREAS, | One of the current Homeland Security work priorities is to work with shelter providers across the region to implement a new FEMA Guidance and so-called functional needs (essentially ADA Compliance) which dovetails with the law enforcement effort which the Gerstacker funds will allow; and |
| WHEREAS, | While the County has a part time accountant for Homeland Security, as well as the fiduciary agent Pat Bostick, this small, one-time grant will not require many transactions and accounting entries and no additional funds to administer are required; and |
