WHEREAS,	Repeated flooding of the Kawkawlin River has caused Bay County residents extensive property damage beyond the river corridor to include the broader coastal area and upstream locations; and
WHEREAS,	Federal emergency response through FEMA has been activated multiple times within the past several years to mobilize for the protection of property from sudden rising flood waters of the Kawkawlin River; and
WHEREAS,	The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has determined the Kawkawlin River channel is not adequately carrying storm flows and the channel capacity has been reduced due to sedimentation in the lower river near the Saginaw Bay; and
WHEREAS,	In its current condition the diminished carrying capacity of the Kawkawlin River channel will continue to pose a serious threat to property in Bay County during unpredictable wind and rain events; and
WHEREAS,	The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has designed a Flood Management channel dredging project that will alleviate flooding threats and improve river corridor safety and Congress has authorized federal funding in the amount of \$564,300 towards the project requiring a local match of the same amount in accordance with the federal Water Resources Development Act of 1986; Therefore, Be It
RESOLVED	That the Bay County Board of Commissioners allocates \$350,000 of ARPA Revenue Recovery dollars to Bangor Township to serve as a portion of the local match for the Kawkawlin River Flood Management dredging project with the United States Corps of Engineers; Bangor Township shall act as the designated fiduciary; Be It Further

WHEREAS,	On March 21, 2023, the Board passed Resolution 2023-37 approving all required budget adjustments necessary for closure and removal of the Bay County Community Center Outdoor Pool as well as to allow release of necessary bids for removal of the pool as may be required to comply with Bay County's purchasing policy; and
WHEREAS,	Administration has indicated that the removal of the existing pool structure will not commence until after the Summer Recreation Program located at the Community Center has concluded; and
WHEREAS,	A Community-Based Committee ("Pool Committee") has been formed in which residents of the County wish to investigate opportunities and possibilities to raise funds to install a new outdoor pool in the same location as the existing Community Center Pool in the future; and
WHEREAS,	in order to allow the Pool Committee to further investigate opportunities for funding it is requested that the Bay County Board of Commissioners "reserve" the existing Community Pool space, after its removal, as open greenspace through December of 2026 to allow the Pool Committee to submit requests to the Board as well as a proposed pool replacement plan, etc.; and
WHEREAS,	There should be little to no financial impact on the general fund by granting the Pool Committee's request. Any de minimis cost would involve upkeep of the green space which can/should be absorbed by the Recreation and Facilities existing budget; Therefore, Be It

WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE (5/2/2023) BY: The Bay County Sheriff's Office is requesting authority to apply for submit a RAP Grant WHEREAS. through Bay County's risk management insurance provider, Michigan Municipal Risk Management Authority (MMRMA) to assist with the purchase of an X-Ray internal and external full body scanner; and The Bay County Sheriff's Office houses up to 274 inmates when at full capacity, with a daily WHEREAS, average of about 180 to 200 inmates; and The jail, on average, books about 55 - 70 arrestees on a weekly basis; and WHEREAS, Corrections staff daily escort prisoners to court which requires exiting and reentering the WHEREAS, secured area of the jail. Drugs, contraband, and weapons are often found on suspects as they enter the jail. Despite a thorough search there are times arrestees smuggle drugs, contraband, and weapons into the jail. Often arrestees will swallow/ingest drugs only to retrieve later and consume which may result in overdoses and/or death; and An X-Ray full body scanner has the ability to detect these items both internally and WHEREAS. externally and eliminate this problem; and The cost of this equipment is anticipated to be no more than \$205,000.00; Therefore, Be It WHEREAS, That the Bay County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Bay County Sheriff's Office to **RESOLVED** apply for and accept the MMRMA RAP Grant to be used towards the purchase of an X-ray internal and external full body scanner and authorizes the Chairman of the Board to execute all applications and grant award documents required for the Grant following Finance and Corporation Counsel review and approval; Be It Further That the grant applicant/recipient departments are required to work with the Finance RESOLVED Department whose staff will provide financial oversight of said grant; Be It Further
