BY:	WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE (9/5/2023)
WHEREAS,	The Countywide Brownfield Redevelopment Authority (BRA) has been awarded their first grant for the redevelopment of a vacant parcel at the intersection of South Euclid and Salzburg Road in Monitor Township; and
WHEREAS,	The project is proposed to be a new Tim Horton's and will create seven (7) full-time and 10-13 part-time jobs; and
WHEREAS,	The site was previously developed and some environmental contamination is anticipated. The EGLE grant of \$300,000 will assist the Developer in covering some of the costs of the environmental actions necessary for site development. The Countywide BRA bylaws require that a grant or loan cannot be accepted unless authorized by resolution of the Board of Commissioners; and
WHEREAS,	The Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) and the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) have a variety of financial tools including grants to support the redevelopment of previously developed sites that are frequently contaminated; and
WHEREAS,	By providing funding assistance to help address costly environmental cleanup and blight, new development/redevelopment is encouraged at properties where the building and surrounding soils have been contaminated from past environmental practices. This creates opportunities for new business growth and new job creation in our community; and
WHEREAS,	The grant award to the BRA is obligated to the project and will cover authorized expenses for site development in coordination with EGLE. The Director of Environmental Affairs and Community Development serves as the technical liaison to the BRA and will provide technical assistance; and

BY:	WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE (9/5/2023)
WHEREAS,	Bay County clerks are faced with yet another change to Michigan's voting system, with the passage
	of Proposal 2022-2; and
WHEREAS,	One of the constitutional amendments requires each jurisdiction to have a precinct open and fully
	staffed for at least nine days of early voting in addition to election day. Bay County has 18
	jurisdictions, of which only one local clerk's office maintains hours each business day and many local
	clerks have other full-time jobs; and
WHEREAS,	Implementation of an early voting location in each township would cost an enormous amount of
	resources, staff time, and money for Bay County taxpayers. The total implementation cost of each
	jurisdiction to individually run their own precinct is estimated to be over \$1,200,000 as opposed to
	the cost of a consolidated county precinct which is estimated to cost \$215,000; and
WHEREAS,	Proposal 2022-2 allows for consolidation among local jurisdictions or with the county clerk to share
	costs and resources for an early voting precinct. The Bay County Clerk, Kathleen Zanotti, has offered
	to host a consolidated early voting precinct that meets all the requirements under the Michigan
WHEDEAC	 Constitution and the Michigan Legislature; and Every Local clerk in Bay County has expressed interest in participating in the Bay County Clerk's early
WHEREAS,	voting precinct. A consolidated Bay County precinct would save Bay County taxpayer money while
	still offering early voting as required by law; and
WHEREAS,	Public Act 81 of 2023 requires that each jurisdiction who wishes to consolidate with the county clerk
	to enter into a county agreement. Each participating Bay County jurisdiction will enter into a cost-
	sharing agreement and be charged a fee of \$8,024 per year. This will cover the staffing, equipment,
	and location expense; and
WHEREAS,	Each early voting precinct is required to have both a designated Election Coordinator and a Site
	Supervisor for each day of early voting. The Bay County Clerk will require additional staff to satisfy
	the requirement of having supervision at the precinct during election hours while still providing
MULTIPEAC	coverage at the Bay County Clerk's office; and In addition to early voting site supervision, the Bay County Elections Coordinator will assist with the
WHEREAS,	open and close of the precinct during the day, the final closing of the precinct on election day, early
	voting election inspector recruitment, early voting election inspector training, processing of election
	inspector wages, create voter education programs and testing of all early voting equipment; and
WHEREAS,	The Election Coordinator, responsible for many duties, will also serve as an administrative assistant
	to the County Election Commission, School District Election Coordinating Committees, and County
	Board of Canvassers; and
WHEREAS,	This full-time position will be funded through the early voting county agreement; Therefore, Be It
RESOLVED	That the Bay County Board of Commissioners approves all agreements and purchases needed to
	effectuate a Bay County Early Voting precinct, including but not limited to the following: posting and
	filling an Elections Coordinator position (PBO6); entering into an Early Voting contract with
