RESOLVED

That the Bay County Board of Commissioners, Bay City, Michigan, does hereby accept the terms of the Agreement as received from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, and that the Bay County Board of Commissioners does hereby specifically agree but not by way of limitation, as follows:

- 1. To appropriate all funds necessary to complete the project during the project period and to provide One Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand, One Hundred Dollars (\$184,100.00) dollars (in-kind) to match the grant authorized by the DEPARTMENT.
- 2. To maintain satisfactory financial accounts, documents and records to make them available to the DEPARTMENT for auditing at reasonable times.
- 3. To construct the project and provide such funds, services, and materials as may be necessary to satisfy the terms of said Agreement.
- 4. To regulate the use of the facility constructed and reserved under this Agreement to assure the use thereof by the public on equal and reasonable terms.
- 5. To comply with any and all terms of said Agreement including all terms not specifically set forth in the foregoing portions of this Resolution.
